CARE WHERE IT COUNTS:

Whistler health care centre to be recognized for excellence in supporting visitors and residents with first-line emergency care, comprehensive community care and options for care in aging

Future health-care priorities:

The draft clinical services plan identifies the following priorities for future health-care planning, engagement and investment in Whistler and the surrounding communities

Acute care:

- Expanded emergency care capacity to support the delivery of timely care for urgent issues
- Expanded ambulatory care, with a focus on cast clinic, visiting specialists and supporting local minor treatments
- Increased access to perinatal services and expanded services in prenatal and postnatal care, including for Indigenous communities
- Increased support for Indigenous communities
- Expanded medical imaging, laboratory and logistical support

Community health:

- Increased capacity in home health, including chronic disease services
- Increased services in public health, such as sexual health and communicable disease programs
- Expanded health protection services, including staff supporting Pemberton area
- Increased mental health and substance use services

Long-term care and supporting services:

- Increased capacity for respite care
- Increased adult day program services
